



Christian J. Kellenberger, MD

Christian Kellenberger serves as radiologist-in-chief at the Kinderspital Zürich. In addition he is adjunct professor for paediatric radiology at the University of Zürich. After medical school and graduating from the University of Berne, he completed his radiology residency (including pathology and surgery) at the Inselspital Berne, followed

by paediatric radiology training at the University Children's Hospital Zürich as well as clinical and research fellowships in cardiac and body imaging at the Department of Diagnostic Imaging, Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto. Since 2004 Dr. Kellenberger has been senior staff radiologist at the Department of Diagnostic Imaging of the University Children's Hospital Zürich, where he became head of department in 2007.

The main clinical and research interests of Dr. Kellenberger are in paediatric cardiovascular and body MRI, including advanced MRI of the kidneys, lungs and temporomandibular joints. As member of the EuroTMjoint research network he has contributed in the development of a TMJ MRI score for juvenile idiopathic arthritis.

Dr. Kellenberger has been an author on more than 90 peer-reviewed journal articles and 10 review articles or book chapters. He has served for several radiology and paediatric journals as reviewer, and is on the editorial board of Pediatric Radiology.

Dr. Kellenberger has participated in scientific commites of Swiss and European paediatric radiology meetings. He has been invited to give over 50 lectures as visiting professor or at Swiss, European and American paediatric radiology courses and congresses.
